



TAO PRIVACY POLICY

This website is run by Trust for Africa's Orphans. We regard your privacy as important and comply with current UK data protection legislation including the UK Data Protection Act 1998 (as amended) and the EU General Data Protection Regulations.

You are welcome to access our site without disclosing your personal data.

We will only use any personal information that you send us in a manner that is appropriate considering the basis on which that data was provided by you. For example we may use your personal information to reply to enquiries you send to us or to handle donations or other fundraising transactions that you initiate.

We will only hold your information for as long as necessary and will not pass it to any other parties unless we have your explicit consent or are required to do so by the law. All employees and staff of the charity who have access to your personal data and are associated with the handling of that data are obliged to respect the confidentiality of your personal data. Your communications to us are protected against unauthorised access by third parties.

If we wish to use your personal data for other purposes, we will offer you the means to positively opt-in and consent to those purposes.
